The sounding book was examined covering the period since 2nd March 1963 when a previous survey was held and the readings found to be acceptable showing no increase in the bilges. The boiler was examined under steam and the bilge pump tested on selected engine room bilges with satisfactory results.

In view of the foregoing the ship is, in my opinion, in a fit state to lie at anchor or moorings in Bombay Harbour for a period of two months from this date i.e. until 20th June 1963.
