

1963 for the purpose of ascertaining her fitness to continue  
to lie in Bombay Harbour until her future is determined.

The sounding book was examined covering the period since  
1st January 1963 when a previous survey was held and the  
readings found to be acceptable showing no increase in the  
bilges. The boiler was examined under steam and the bilge  
pump tested on selected engine room bilges with satisfactory  
results.

In view of the foregoing the ship is, in my opinion, in a fit  
state to lie at anchor or moorings in Bombay Harbour for a  
period of one month from this date i.e. until 22nd April 1963.
