

FREEBOARD REPORT on ~~the~~ Messrs. Charles Hill's No 186 Ship.

It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those required by the Tables, merit approval, subject to the dimensions & particulars now supplied being verified on completion of the vessel, and to there being no side-scuttles or other openings in the vessel's sides to affect the position of the load-line disc.

The freeboards have been computed on an assumed corrected tonnage coefficient of .68, & are therefore, subject to revision if necessary. In submitting his final report the surveyor should confirm the amount of Trim by stern - viz 36 inches and should state the distance of the centre of flotation of the vessel's waterplane abaft the middle of the vessel's length.
