Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 26th instant, with reference to the provisional freeboard for Messrs Chas. Hill & Sons No. 136, I have to state that the <sup>Sheer</sup> freeboards measured from a line parallel to the top of keel and passing through the deck at side, at the middle of the vessel's length, are stated to be as follows :-

| At the stem ... ..  | 3'0                 |
| At 1/8th the vessel's length from the stem                      | 1'5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " |
| At the after perpendicular ...                                  | 2'6"                |
| At 1/8th of the vessel's length from the after perpendicular... | 1'4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " |
