Dr. Herdman, the Principal Scientist connected with the operations of this vessel, has to-day requested that when the vessel returns to this port at the end of this month, a General Examination, in drydock, may be held with a view to the postponement of the Special Survey, due 3,62, for a period of about six months. He states that it is expected that this vessel will not be required after July, 1962. He also states that she will be in Plymouth from 27th November, 1961 to 4th January, 1962.

I shall be glad to receive confirmation that it will be in order to proceed with the required General Examination and that subsequently the current L.L. Certificate may be endorsed for a further period corresponding to the extent of the deferment period.
