This ship was built in 1929-11.

A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 3,62 but postponement until 3,63 was approved 25.1.62, a satisfactory G.E. having been held at Plymouth in 1,62.

The Notation of "Laid Up - Surveys Overdue" was recorded in the R.B. 5.4.63.

The ship has since been sold for breaking up and the Notation of "To be broken up" was inserted in the R.B. 31.5.63.

The Plymouth Surveyors who were instructed by London letter of 14.5.63, reported 5,63 ship examined afloat and the requirements of a G.E. complied with, prior to the ship proceeding under her own power from Plymouth to Passage West, Ireland where it is stated the ship is to be broken up.

In view of the above, IT IS SUBMITTED no further Action needs be taken meantime, pending receipt of definite information that the ship has been broken up.
