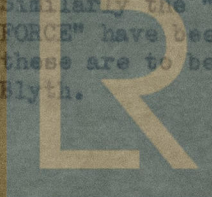
ANSWER

With reference to your letter of the 19th and my reply the 20th January, I shall be glad to learn how these cases stand.

S.S. "DALEGARTH FORCE" & S.S. "STOCK FORCE".

The Owners of these two ships decided they were not prepared to take the vessels to the Continent for breaking up as soon as they heard that the Classification Committee required dry docking before the vessels put to sea again. They promised to let us know when a decision had been reached but it was only today that we were advised that the "DALEGARTH FORCE" was sold to B.I.S.C.O. last month for breaking up purposes at Granton, Firth of Forth. Similarly the "STOCK FORCE" and "SINKER FORCE" have been sold to B.I.S.C.O. and these are to be broken up at the Docks at Blyth.
