Replying to your letter of the 19th January and in confirmation of our telephone conversation this afternoon, I have to acquaint you that if these ships are to proceed to the Continent, say Belgium, for breaking up, as classed ships, the Committee will require them to be examined in dry dock and found or placed in satisfactory condition for the proposed voyage.

So far as the machinery is concerned, a general examination of the boilers internally will be necessary and an examination of the engines under working conditions.

As the Annual Load Line Surveys are overdue in each case these inspections must be held before leaving your district.
