In reply to your letter of the 23rd. instant, respecting our First Entry Report No. 11976 on the M.S. "DELIUS", we have to inform you that the two panting stringers fitted below the third deck are as approved, viz. 6" $3\frac{1}{2}$ " .43" face angles and .43" intercostal plates. The thickness of the latter was given in error as .38".

We have to state further that reverse angles have been fitted in the centre span on alternate beams at the 2nd and 3rd decks, as approved.
