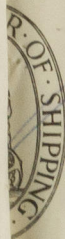

Any further comments that you may care to make on the proposed endorsement would be appreciated.

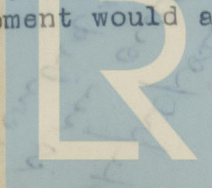
I would add that due note has been taken of the contents of your memoranda dated the 8th January, 1957 and 20th February, 1958, which deal mainly with hull and equipment.
