I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant with reference to the provisional freeboard assignment in respect of your No. 596 ship and in reply have to inform you that in making the computation in this case, the fullest possible allowance was made for the after erection regarding it as a combination of bridge, poop and raised quarter deck combined.

I may remind you that the freeboard assigned is set off from the top of the .72 stringer plate. It has been assumed that there are no openings in the bridge front bulkhead.
