
Remarks of the Chief Engineer Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

The torsional vibration characteristics of the main machinery were approved in Secretary's letter of 13. 6. 46 for a service speed of 280 r.p.m. provided a notice board be fitted at the Control Station stating that the main engine must not be run continuously between 167 and 196 r.p.m.

The machinery certificate should be endorsed accordingly and a suitable entry made in the S.R. List.


The requirements for "Strengthened for Navigation in Ice" have been carried out, except for the supplying of a spare propeller of suitable materials.

This vessel's machinery appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed LMC 4.47.

"Strengthened for Navigation in Ice".

Subject to a spare propeller of approved and tested materials being placed on board at the first opportunity.

The Greenock Surveyors should be informed it is noted the test certificates covering various electric motors for essential services have not yet come to hand, and that they will forward same as soon as possible.
