Dear Sirs:

In reply to your letter of the 19th, and 21st, inst., submitting for approval the above plans in quadruplicate, I have to inform you that these will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon, the remaining requirements of the Rules for Pumping and Riping be complied with so far as they are applicable, and the work be carried out under the supervision and to the entire satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

With regard to the plan showing the arrangements of the boilers, I have to point out that Chapter E. Paragraph 327 of the Rules, requires that where water tube boilers are installed, there should be a space of at least 2' 6" between the tank top and the under side of the pans forming the bottom of the conversion spaces. I conclude that as there is only 24" between the under side of the pan and the tank top that oil fuel will not be carried in the double bottom tank under the boilers but I shall be glad if you will confirm this.

One copy of each of the approved plans is being returned herewith.
