With reference to my letter of the 9th March, I shall be pleased to learn whether you have yet been able to obtain copies of the Approved Plans in connection with the alterations which were effected at Newport News during the period October to January.

As a result of the above survey the class was continued subject to midship deep tank top plating being examined and dealt with as found necessary on arrival at Valparaiso. It is noted from the Shipping Papers, however, that the vessel has since been to Valparaiso, but has not been reported under survey, and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Owners and let me know what arrangements they propose to make for this condition of class to be dealt with, and also for the installation of an emergency fire pump.

At the same time I shall be glad if you will request the Owners to state their intentions regarding the completion of the Engine Survey, by the examination of the following items:-

Main Engine:

H.P., I.P., and L.P. crankpins and bearings,
H.P., I.P., and L.P. Crossheads and bearings,
H.P., I.P., and L.P. Eccentric sheaves and straps.
Main Engine attached bilge pump.

Fan engine, anchor windlass and engine, fuel oil transfer pump.
