Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in Amsterdam in December 1932

Please see Amsterdam report No. 16322 (Report 8)

In No. 6 lower tween deck all scuppers of upper tweendeck, fitted with non-return valves have been made workable and positive means of closing are fitted on the upper tween deck as reported with indication whether the valves are open or closed. The upper tween deck is now accessible at all times and in my opinion the arrangement may be approved.

In No. 1 lower tweendeck (also accommodation space, and accessible at all times) ordinary valves with handwheels have now been fitted to the scuppers from the upper tweendeck and the situation is in accordance with rule requirements.
