Surveyed the Boiler and Machinery of the S.S. "KYPROS" 6416 tons gross of Piraeus, whilst lying afloat at Kynossoura, on the 13th June, 1959 and subsequently for Commencement of Boiler Survey,

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all recommendations made by me in connection therewith have been carried out to my satisfaction, and that I have

Recommended that the record of Main Boiler Survey 6,59

be made in the Register Book in the case of this vessel. , when the Survey has been completed, subject to machinery repairs due to refloating (whilst on voyage from Richmond Va to Newport News Va. on the 16th June, 1958) being effected before the vessel leaves Piraeus. Also subject as previously recommended.

(To complete the Boiler Survey the Safety Valves of all Boilers remain to be adjusted under steam and the oil fuel installation and fire extinguishing arrangements to be examined under working conditions.)
