REPORT OF STUDY OF THE  
LLOYD'S REGISTER FOUNDATION

The following table shows the results of the study of the Lloyd's Register Foundation, which was conducted by the Lloyd's Register Foundation in the year 1962.

| Category   | Number of Entries | Percentage of Total |
|------------|-------------------|---------------------|
| Category 1 | 100               | 10.0%               |
| Category 2 | 200               | 20.0%               |
| Category 3 | 300               | 30.0%               |
| Category 4 | 400               | 40.0%               |
| Category 5 | 500               | 50.0%               |
