I am obliged to you for your cablegram of the 27th November, from which it is noted that this vessel is now at your port, but that no arrangements have yet been made for the overdue Special Survey to be held.

The Committee desire the Owners to be informed that this vessel must comply with the Society's Regulations before she again leaves your port or her class will automatically be withdrawn. To comply with our Regulations it will be necessary either for a Special Survey to be held, or a General Examination in lieu to be carried out with a view to the survey being postponed for such period as may be determined by the condition of the ship, but not extending beyond July, 1962.

The Owners must also appreciate that the vessel's class cannot be left unqualified for any indefinite period and that if the survey is not held within a reasonable time, the Committee reserve the right to suspend the class.
