I confirm our telephone conversation yesterday from which it was learnt that the Owners desire to send this vessel from Rotterdam to Hamburg to load a cargo of phosphate for Formosa and thence in ballast to Hong Kong where she should arrive mid September next, and will then be broken up.

The case has been under consideration today and I am authorised to say that the Committee will be agreeable to maintenance of class for this voyage provided the Surveyors are satisfied as to the ship's condition in view of the survey held in dry dock last August as reported in Rotterdam Report No.45971.
