

EXTRACT FROM LOG OF S.S. "FORT ORLEANS".

Saturday, 27th November, 1943.

- 1303 Alongside and securely moored.
1432 Standby Engines.
1449 Let go and proceeded to bay for gun trials and A.D. trials.
1630 Ceased trials and proceeded to calibrate D.F.
1840 Completed calibration.
1845 Pilot and D.F. man left ship.
1903 Full away.
1915 Log streamed and set. Race Rocks abeam.
Light wind, cloudy weather and fine.
2040 Vessel turned around and making for Victoria.
2343 Stand by Engines.
2350 Reduced speed.

Sunday, 28th November, 1943.

- 0032 Let go anchor.
0042 Brought up to Anchor and finished with Engines.
Light breeze and calm sea.
Fine and clear weather.
Anchor bearings frequently checked.
B.O.T. regulations complied with.
0400-0800
Bearings checked.
Light wind.
Fine and clear weather.
