I, the undersigned, do hereby certify that I did at the request of Messrs. Ireland Fraser & Co. Ltd. Llyods Agents at Port-Louis, Mauritius, survey on the 10th. & 11th. day of May, 1959 the S.S. "CLAN KENNEDY" whilst afloat in Port-Louis Harbour for a flexible distance piece (made of rubber) as fitted to outlet pipe of Main Condenser and report as under :-

' This distance piece was perished and had to be renewed, a new piece was fabricated, body made of $\frac{3}{4}$ " and flanges $7/8$ " mild steel plates, mean overall length 2'0". This was fitted to outlet pipe tested in place and found alright.

' I consider vessel, after this repair, fit to proceed to sea and fit to retain her class.'
