imilarly to that of her sister vessels.

The "TREMATON" is a standard A type steamer and  
menting was worked in the double bottom tanks under the machinery  
aces and in the tank side bilges throughout the vessel in the  
ual manner. Peaks were also cemented.

For the remaining spaces of the double bottom a  
triangular fillet of cement was fitted at the seams only. The  
lating inside the double bottom being otherwise coated with cement  
ash.
