

*and that I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that ~~all repairs recommended by~~ ~~have been completed to my satisfaction, also that~~ I will recommend that she be retained as now classed with fresh record of S.S. 2/60, subject to shellplates E 6+7 (ss) from aft, E 2 (ps) from aft and G 9 (ps) from forward etc. to be specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next Special Survey 3/60 and to any other conditions which may be at present attached to the ship's class being dealt with as previously recommended.*
