The class is subject to 49 wood hatch covers being renewed on vessel's arrival at a Yugoslav port.

The SPLIT Surveyor reports (9.48) the vessel afloat and both lower masts renewed.

The same Surveyor reported (30.8.48) the 49 wood hatch covers, as above, fitted. (See endorsement 1.10.48).

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed, without special condition.
