Since making our returns at the end of the year, the following has been brought to our attention and no doubt you may wish to make the necessary alterations in the Register Book:-

"RECUPERADO" EX PINHEL - N^o in R.B.:- 77144 - The above vessel previously belonging to Sociedade Geral de Comércio, Indústria e Transportes was accepted by Underwriters as a total loss but she has now been recovered and re-conditioned and given the name as above. The Port of Registry remains as before as Lisbon and the present owners are the people who salvaged the ship, Messrs. Eugénio & Severino, but they do not intend to operate it and the ship is meantime laid up here awaiting a buyer. We would advise you again of the future developments.

* m.v. "CORUCHE" - N^o in R.B.:- 57921 - No doubt you have noticed on the Press the unfortunate fate of the above vessel which we understand is a total loss. For your private information, we believe that she had a cargo of more than 5,000 drums of petrol and whilst discharging this cargo at Bissau, Guiné, a drum or drums were dropped and the vessel got fire. It is understood that no personnel was lost and the vessel was towed out of the port when it was realised that the fire could not be extinguished. If we eventually obtain further information about the vessel we will advise you.

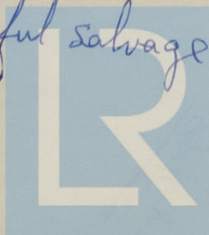
