Alterations.

This Survey, due 11.34 partly held at \_\_\_\_\_ now completed, and the following repairs carried out (due to wear & tear):-

A number of rivets in combustion chambers of both forward boilers, also a few tubes & stays renewed.  
Screw shaft-exam<sup>d</sup>. & stem bush re-wooded.

Alterations consequent on shortening of vessel:-

Propeller changed for one of different scantings.  
Bilge & tank sections to forward deep tank blanked off.  
Electric circuits altered as necessary.

It is submitted the vessel is eligible to remain as classed, with notation of BS 2.35 as recommended.
