Messrs. Charles Connell & Co., Ltd., visit the new Steel Screw Steamer "MATHURA", of Liverpool, 9743 tons gross register, for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of the damage stated to have been caused by grounding in the river Clyde and striking the quay wall of Queen's Dock, Glasgow, after launching on the 18th May, 1920.

Examined this vessel while lying afloat in Queen's Dock, Glasgow, and found No. 8 Tank full of water. Recommended vessel be placed in dry dock for further examination and on the 11th December, 1920, examined vessel in Govan Dry Dock and found docking plug to No. 8 Tank missing. Recommended that No. 8 Tank be cleaned out and cement washed.

The foregoing recommendations are made to place the vessel in the same good and efficient condition as before the damage was sustained.
