Reverting to your letter of the 19th June last enclosing one from Mr. Moir relative to the freeboard of the s.s. "MATHURA", I have to acquaint you that the Special Survey No.3 of this vessel was completed as regards the hull at this port in September last but the Surveyor did not report upon the freeboard, and consequently fresh certificates were not issued.

In reply to enquiry regarding the survey for the renewal of the freeboard certificate, which will expire at the end of the present month, the Society's Liverpool Office write that they have been informed by the Owners' Superintendent that arrangements will be made for the survey in question to be held at an early date probably at Glasgow.

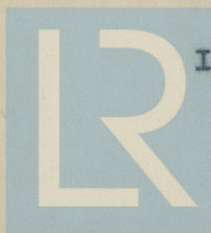
I shall therefore be glad if the Surveyors will be guided accordingly.
