Dear Sir,

With reference to my letter of the 15th instant regarding the freeboard certificates of the S.S. "MATHURA", No. 67367 in the Register Book, and to the Secretary's reply of the 16th instant, I have to state that I am now informed by the Captain and the Superintendent that, owing to the coaling arrangements made for the voyage, they regret that it will not be possible for them to carry out their original proposal to complete the Special Survey No. 3 in Calcutta, and that they are arranging to complete same on the vessel's return to London before the end of the year and to obtain new certificates at that time.

The new freeboard certificates which are issued, subject to the S.S. No. 3 being completed in Calcutta, are therefore returned herewith, the old certificates having been retained on the vessel.

I wish also to state for your information that the "Hinged wood door" shewn on the certificate closing appliances to the forecastle give access to unattached side houses only.
