Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that a Convention freeboard certificate was issued on the 31st January last in respect of the s.s. "MATHURA" valid until the 31st December, 1933 and the Special Survey No.3 of this vessel has now been completed at Glasgow with the exception of the examination of the lower bunkers, testing of No.4 double bottom tank and the making good of the cargo battens.

These items will be completed on the vessel's arrival at Calcutta to which port she is now proceeding.

In the circumstances a fresh Convention freeboard certificate valid for a period of five years has been issued subject to the outstanding items being completed with at your port as proposed, and I shall therefore be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention.

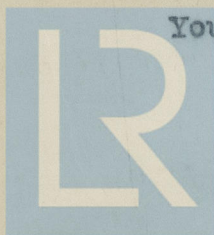
