Dear Sir,

With reference to the freeboard of the S.S. "MATHURA", I beg to state that the No. 3 Survey has now been completed with the exception of the examination of the lower bunkers, testing of No. 4 double bottom tank and the making good of the cargo battens.

These items will be completed on the vessel's arrival at Calcutta to which port she is now proceeding.

The Owners are desirous of having new freeboard certificates for a period of 5 years and, as the vessel is sailing on Saturday, I shall be glad to receive these by return of post.

As the vessel has been laid up since the freeboard was verified in January, it was not considered necessary to verify the freeboard and to hold the Renewal Survey.
