Dear Sir,

I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 20th instant requesting to be advised as to what fee should be charged for the services rendered by the Augsburg Surveyor in testing machinery parts intended for the s.s. "KOTA GEDE" which is presently under construction at Messrs. My Fyenoord, Rotterdam.

The matter has been taken up with the Augsburg Surveyor and it appears that approximately 60% of all the machinery parts for this vessel have been tested at Augsburg, the number of visits being 23.

As the N.H.P. of the machinery of the s.s. "KOTA GEDE" is stated to be 1857, it is considered that 60% of 4/5th of the Rule fee + £70 plus £2 travelling expenses should be credited to the Bremen account on completion of the vessel.
