
I acknowledge receipt of your further letter of the 24th instant, the contents of which have been noted.

Provided a Comprehensive General Examination is carried out including drydocking and the ship is found or placed in satisfactory condition, permission will be given for the proposed voyage in ballast from Greece to Japan as an unclassified ship. Special attention should be given to any outstanding conditions of class together with any minor defects which have been left to the Owners' initiative. Closing appliances should also receive attention.

As regards the machinery the following items mentioned in my letter of the 23rd instant need not be opened out provided they are found to work satisfactorily during trials:-

Forward SW circulating pump
FW circulating pump
After lubricating oil cooler
One FW cooler
One air compressor
The port auxiliary dynamo engine
One lubricating oil cooler.
