We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 184 building by Messrs. Kockums Mek. Verkstads AB. Mr. for Messrs. S.H. Smith Sørensen; Arendal, Norway of ab. 8100 Tons. Length 460'-0" Breadth 59'-6" , Depth 34'-7" intended to be Classed Lloyd's Register 100 A 1 Carrying petroleum in bulk.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
