*and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am **Recommending** that she be retained as now classed without fresh record of survey, subject to crack in shell plating 2nd below sheer between frames 23 & 24 (p.s.) in No. 5 hold, and hole in shell plating 3rd below sheer (s.s.) in boiler room being specially examined and dealt with as necessary on arrival at Piraeus where the ship is now proceeding in ballast condition. Also subject to all other conditions at present attached to the ship's class being dealt with as previously recommended.*


