Dear Sirs,

S.S. "NAHOON" - Yard No. 334.

I am in receipt of your letter of the 21st inst. in regard to the above vessel, and in reply I have to inform you that, if the opening in the watertight bulkhead between the hold and the cross bunker is as desired by the Owners and is required in order that coal may be transferred from the hold to the bunker during the voyage out to the vessel's destination, provided the opening in the watertight bulkhead be closed by means of a bolted plate fitted to the Surveyor's satisfaction, and a letter be received from the Owners stating that this plate will be permanently riveted up on the vessel's arrival at her destination, the proposal will be approved.
