S.S. "TENACODUS"

With reference to the provisional classification assigned to this vessel, I have to inform you that the Committee have had before them the report of survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff in June last, from which it is noted that the Special Survey for classification on the hull has been completed in dry dock, the survey of the boilers carried out and the screwshaft drawn for examination.

Notations of S.S.Cff.-6,48., Docking Survey 6,48. BS 6,48. and Shaft examined 5,48. have been assigned, but I think it well to inform you that to complete the survey of the machinery and render the vessel eligible for full classification, the following items require to be examined, viz:-

- Air compressors
- Air receiver
- De-aerator and 2nd stage feed-heater
- Fire pumps
- After bilge pump
- Oil fuel transfer pump
- Auxiliary condensate pump
- Auxiliary circulating pump
- Pumping arrangements
- Main propulsion motor, and *bearings*
- Electrical equipment.
