
~~REPAIRS TO ENGINES AND BOILERS DUE TO DAMAGE THROUGH-~~

The class is subject to the machinery spare gear being brought up to Rule requirements; the electric fittings in the centre castle 'tween deck space being replaced by fittings of flame proof type and to a spare propeller being supplied.

The Cardiff Surveyors now confirm that the electrical fittings as above, have been dealt with as required and have reported that the spare gear is now in accordance with Rule requirements, except that a spare propeller remains to be supplied.

IT IS SUBMITTED that the vessel's Contemplated Class be made subject to a spare propeller being supplied, but without other special conditions.
