S.S. "TENAGODUS"

We would refer to the certificate issued by your surveyor at Port Said on the 17th ultimo stating the above ship is eligible for classification subject to 120 fathoms of chain cable of approved size and test being placed on board on the vessel's arrival at a U.K. port, also to a spare bower anchor being placed on board at the earliest opportunity.

In this connection we would advise you that due to circumstances beyond our control the original programme for the ship to discharge at Heysham has had to be amended and in consequence she will now discharge at Swansea, where she is due on the 15th instant. As intimated previously we have an anchor and a 120 fathoms of cable available for the ship and it had been our intention to divert her from Heysham where she was originally to discharge to the Mersey for the purpose of placing this equipment on board.

The ship's services are urgently required for a further voyage to Abadan to load for the U.K. again, after which she will be withdrawn from service for the purpose of drydocking and strapping. To avoid unnecessary expense also diversion we are now proposing to have the cable available on the Mersey sent to the ship at her drydocking port where it will be fitted concurrently with other repairs. Under the circumstances, we should feel obliged if you would give consideration to allowing the ship to make a further voyage with her present equipment and also inform your surveyor in Swansea in this matter.

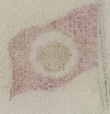
