Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the proposal contained in your cable of the 4th instant regarding the equipment of the T.2 Tanker "TENAGODUS" was duly approved, and I cabled you to this effect on the 6th instant.

With regard thereto, I think it well to point out that the chain cable supplied to this vessel is of high tensile steel so that a diameter of 2.5/16" in this material is allowable in lieu of the 2.11/16" wrought iron generally required by the Rules. Having regard to the lesser weight of high tensile steel, however, there is no emergency reduction permissible.

The Owners were aware of this and are making arrangements for replace chain accordingly.
