Steamer "PETER" now named "KETTARA V"

It is understood from the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp that you have taken over the Ownership of this vessel.

This ship was under survey at Antwerp last month when an examination was made of the repairs which had previously been carried out to the M.P. slide valve chest bottom, the M.P. cylinder bottom and wall on the starboard side and the M.P. slide valve chest on the starboard side.

The repairs to these parts were considered to remain efficient, but it was recommended that they should be again examined by the end of May, 1961. The Committee have continued the class subject to this inspection being held by that time.
