I am in receipt of your letter of the 17th instant regarding the notation of Classification in the Society's Register Book of the Cable and Oil Tank Steamer No. 472, "NEPTUN", which has just been completed by Messrs. Blohm & Voss, Hamburg, and your remarks have been carefully noted.

In reply thereto I am directed to state that, in accordance with the desire of the Owners and Builders, the class "Carrying Petroleum in Cylindrical Tanks" could, in the circumstances, be amended to "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk", but as in all cases in which cylindrical tanks are fitted these are specially brought out in the classification, and it is considered necessary to add the words "Cylindrical Tanks", thus indicating the special characteristics of the construction of the vessel.

The classification could therefore be 100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk", with the special notations "Cable Vessel", "Cylindrical Tanks", and "Longitudinal Framing".
