The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

Intimation has been received from the new Owners that they did not desire to continue the classification of this vessel in the Society's Register Book after the 20th ultimo.

The Owners were informed that in due course the case would be submitted for the consideration of the Committee with a view to the class being withdrawn.

The attached report has now been received from the Rotterdam Surveyors. The vessel has been placed in drydock, the bottom coated and on account of damage, cause not stated, a number of shell plates and frames have been faired. Repairs to bilge keel tested as required and found tight and minor repairs carried out.

The Surveyors recommend a fresh record of survey 4,39.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be now withdrawn and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
