Motor Tanker "CONSTANCE"

We refer to your letter of 28th September and would confirm telephone conversation with Mr. Cook yesterday when the question of extending the validity of the Load Line Certificate a further month, until the end of December, was discussed.

As you are already aware, the present time charter expires about the 20th November and the vessel will thereafter be handed back to the Owners at Chittagong.

According to a letter dated 8th instant from the Captain to the Owners, the General Examination and Load Line Survey required by your letter of the 28th September, was carried out at Chittagong and the Load Line Survey extended to 30th November.

As intimated by telephone the Owners have had the offer of a cargo to be lifted at Singapore on their way round from Chittagong to Japan, where the vessel will be sold for scrap or laid up. The further extension to the Load Line Certificate is necessary to allow them to close with this offer.

We have now informed the Owners that the Load Line Certificate may be extended for a further month, till the end of December, provided a satisfactory Load Line Survey is carried out before the end of November. It is the Owners intention that this survey be carried out at Chittagong on expiry of the Charter and they would be grateful if you would instruct the Surveyors accordingly.
