Motor Tanker "CONSTANCE"

With reference to my letter of the 28th September it is understood from the Owners that the requisite Load Line Survey has been held at your port and that a short term certificate valid until the end of November 1962 has been issued.

I am informed by the Principal Surveyor for Sweden that the Owners now find they are in a position to run this vessel for one more voyage on their own account before sending her to Japan for scrapping.

The Owners have therefore appealed for a further extension to the end of December 1962 and this has been agreed by the Committee provided a further Load Line Survey is held by you and the vessel is found to be generally in a fit condition for the further period contemplated. I shall therefore be obliged if you will give this matter the necessary attention when so requested by the ship's Local Agents.

On completion of this additional inspection it will be in order for you to issue another short term Load Line certificate valid until the end of December provided you are satisfied.


