I am in receipt of your letter of the 27th instant and in reply would explain that so far as this Society is concerned, no objection will be taken to the vessel carrying a cargo of oil in the midship deep tanks and deep tank aft on the proposed voyage from the Mediterranean to Bombay, provided the survey now in hand in Piraeus is completed to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyor at that port.

Should a Loadline Certificate be desired for the voyage, the Surveyor would be authorised to issue a Loadline Certificate valid for three months for the voyage to Bombay, provided all the conditions of assignment, as intimated to him from this Office, are complied with and provided the survey for classification is completed.
