I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the June last together with enclosure regarding the classification above named vessel.

A copy of your letter and enclosure was handed to the Mr. Coucoubanis who stated as the vessel was laid up the matter would be dealt with on his return from England where he is now proceeding. The matter of outstanding fees was also discussed and he agreed to pay immediately half of the amount but the account remains outstanding.

Meanwhile through other sources attempts were made to deal with the items referred to in your letter but without success.

On the 21st instant I was informed by Mr. Catsoulakis, Assistant A.B. Surveyor that the vessel would be classed by the American Bureau. No reason was given for this change.

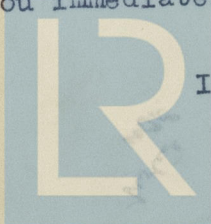
I immediately contacted Mr. Hopkins the A.B. Surveyor at this Port and in a cordial interview on the 23rd instant I was informed that the Owner had requested classification with his society. He stated that he had been shown a provisional Load Line Certificate issued by me expiring on the 31st May 1950 and he assumed the vessel was no longer under our Survey.

Our position with regard to classification was put before Mr. Hopkins who admitted he had not been informed of all the facts relating to this vessel and has now proposed to submit the case to the New York office.

Mr. Hopkins has stated that he will advise me in due course and I will not fail to inform you immediately on receipt of further information.
