We are in receipt of your classing letter of the 1st inst. and in reply have to state that the strengthening of the vessel's bottom forward and the strengthening of the double bottom under the pillars is satisfactory. Gusset plates have been fitted forward of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  length on every frame as indicated in the approved plan.

The machinery spaces have been examined and the water tanks in way of the tunnel aft have been examined and tested.

The overall length of the vessel is 476' - 2".

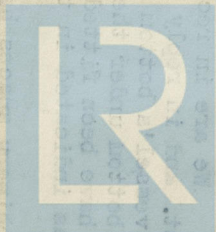
