Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acquaint you that the case of the Motorship "EMPIRE MOWDDACH" has now received consideration in connection with the survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg in January 1946/July 1947. As a result of this inspection the vessel has been classed 100A1 With fbd., 4,47 Ham., subject to the sternframe (electrically welded) being specially examined at the next drydocking and to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the end of the present emergency. Notations of "S.S.Ham.-7,47", "IMC 7,47", "S(CL) 3,47" and "Classed 7,47" have also been assigned and Classification certificates in respect of the Special Survey of the hull and machinery are enclosed.
