Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 6th ult. respecting the motorships "EMPIRE ALDER" ex "PELIKAN" and "EMPIRE MOWDDACH" ex "PONTOS". I have to refer to the recent conversations with Mr. Grandison respecting these vessels and to confirm that it has now been arranged with the Ministry of Transport that the whole of the classification requirements, including the refrigerating machinery, should be carried out as far as practicable, and that in any case all classification requirements should be completed in way of those spaces which are going to be insulated. This will avoid the necessity of removing any insulation when the survey is completed if circumstances do not allow of the full requirements being carried out at this time.
